



Strategic use of digital technology for whole-school improvement

This is a three-session programme focussing on how schools can formulate and implement a strategic plan for the use of digital technology as a key component of successful whole-school improvement of learning and teaching.

With a new Digital Competence Framework being launched in 2016, schools need to think carefully about the strategic use of digital technology in order to have an impact on learning and teaching.

The programme will support delegates with strategic, whole-school planning with the use of the layered 'Burger Model'.

The programme will give delegates the opportunity to see first-hand the way in which digital technology is used effectively in classrooms and examples of pupils' work, lesson planning and takeaway materials will be provided.

Also delegates will be given the opportunity to network within the group and use information and evidence from their own schools to develop discussions and further enquiry.
